


CPA's Power Response Home Program

Save energy, earn money.

Overview

Clean Power Alliance (CPA) is your not-for-profit clean energy provider serving your community since 2019. CPA offers residential customers through the Power Response Home Program the opportunity to earn money by reducing their electricity use. By participating, customers can earn money during Energy Saving Events, which occur during times when energy demand is unseasonably high. Those enrolled in Power Response Home can earn \$2 for each kilowatt hour of energy they save!

How to enroll



All CPA residential customers with a smart meter are eligible for Power Response Home if they are not already enrolled in another demand response program.

What is an Energy Saving Event?

Energy Saving Events occur during times when energy demand is unseasonably high. Customers enrolled in Power Response Home will be notified 24 hours in advance about an Energy Saving Event. You can select how you would like to be notified, either through email or text. Events typically occur on weekdays between the hours of 4-9 pm and will not last more than four hours. What to do when an Energy Saving Event is called

Here are some easy tips to reduce your electricity use:

Charge Later



Delay charging your electric vehicle at home.



Air Dry



Air dry clothing and dishes instead of using your appliances.

Adjust





During the summer, adjust the temperature on your thermostat to 78 degrees.

Wait





Delay running your washing machine and dishwasher until 9pm.

Turn Off



Turn off any unnecessary lights.

Unplug



Avoid charging devices, and unplug any appliances that are not being used.

Power Down



Cook



Cook with your outdoor grill or microwave to keep your home cooler.

How much money can be earned?

- All participants will receive \$2 for every kilowatt hour of energy saved.
- The participation incentives will be provided once a year in the form of a digital gift card via email.
- Income-qualified customers and customers in under-resourced communities may qualify for a \$20 digital gift card delivered via email when they successfully enroll in Power Response Home.
