

Understanding Your Bill

Clean Power Alliance knows utility bills can be confusing. We are here to help.

Your monthly electricity bill consists of charges from both Clean Power Alliance (CPA) and Southern California Edison (SCE) as well as state required charges and taxes.

CPA

Charges on your bill are for the clean energy that we purchase on behalf of our customers — this is called a generation charge.

- The electricity cost on your bill reflects the specific energy option you have selected: 100% Green Power (100% renewable energy), Clean Power (50% clean energy) or Lean Power (40% clean energy).
- All electricity purchased for you or your business comes from CPA.

SCE

Your monthly electric bill is sent to you by SCE. CPA does not own or operate the infrastructure that delivers electricity to you.

- SCE charges reflect the cost of delivering electricity to you.
- As a CPA customer, your bill will show an SCE account number because SCE is responsible for sending your bill and getting electricity to your home or business.

This sample bill is representative of a residential customer on the domestic time of use rate and does not reflect specific customer data or all customer rate options. If you have questions about your rates, please contact CPA customer service for assistance.

2 This section provides a summary of your billing details and breaks out SCE and CPA charges. CPA charges are not an additional charge — they simply replace the generation charges that would have been on your bill from SCE.

Things you should know

Fixed Recovery Charge
SCE has been permitted to issue bonds that enable it to recover more quickly certain costs related to preventing a catastrophic wildfire. Your bill for electric service includes a Fixed Recovery Charge that has been approved by the those bonds. The right to recover the Fixed Recovery Charge has been transferred to a separate entity (called the Entity) that issued the bonds and does not belong to SCE. SCE is collecting the Fixed Recovery Charge on behalf of Purpose Entity.

- 4** The details of your new charges section indicates how much energy you used during the billing period at each Time-of-Use rate for your SCE delivery charges. Electricity prices are typically lower early in the day, overnight, and on weekends.
- 5** Detail of your SCE Delivery Charges.
- 6** Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) charges are surcharges paid by all CCA electricity customers.
- The DWR Bond Charge and CTC (Competition Transition Charge) are legacy charges, some of which are currently used to support the California Wildfire Fund.
- The PCIA (Power Charge Indifference Adjustment) is a fee charged to CCA customers for the costs associated with energy contracts that are collected by SCE. CPA adjusts its generation rates to account for PCIA and to keep our customers' total bills competitive with SCE.
- 8** POD-ID= Point of Delivery Identification number. The POD-ID is a unique account number that identifies the location of service.
- 9** Your rate (CPA) and billing period.
- 10** Detail of CPA's Generation Charges.
- 11** The Utility Users Tax is established by local city or county ordinances and is collected on your electricity bill. It is not charged by your energy provider.
- 12** The Energy Surcharge is collected from all electricity customers statewide to fund clean energy programs and projects, including the activities of the California Energy Commission.
