Introduction and Key Information

This document contains the applicable rates and credits for customers participating in the Clean Power Alliance Power Share and Community Solar programs. These rates and credits are periodically adjusted to ensure that Power Share and Community Solar program participants receive a 20% total bill discount based on their current rate schedule, in addition to any other applicable California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) or Family Electric Rate Assistance (FERA) discounts. Customers enrolled in Power Share and Community Solar receive 100% renewable energy produced in communities defined as “disadvantaged” according to California Assembly Bill (AB) 327 within Clean Power Alliance or Southern California Edison (SCE) service territory.

Rate Period Definitions

The name of your Clean Power Alliance rate schedule may not exactly match your SCE rate, as Clean Power Alliance offers simplified, consolidated rate options. This will not impact service, billing, or CARE, FERA, or Medical Baseline status. Seasons

For all rate schedules, seasons are defined as follows:

- **Summer:** season shall commence at 12:00 a.m. on June 1 and continue until 12:00 a.m. on October 1 of each year.
- **Winter:** season shall commence at 12:00 a.m. on October 1 of each year and continue until 12:00 a.m. on June 1 of the following year.

Holidays

Applicable holidays for rate time periods are as follows: New Year's Day (January 1), Presidents' Day (third Monday in February), Memorial Day (last Monday in May), Independence Day (July 4), Labor Day (first Monday in September), Veterans Day (November 11), Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November), and Christmas Day (December 25).

When any holiday listed above falls on Sunday, the following Monday will be recognized as a holiday. No change will be made for holidays falling on Saturday.

- **On-Peak:** 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. summer weekdays except holidays
- **Mid-Peak:** 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. summer weekends/holidays and winter all days
- **Off-Peak:** all other hours summer; 9:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. winter all days
- **Super Off-Peak:** 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. winter all days

- **On-Peak:** 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. summer weekdays except holidays
- **Mid-Peak:** 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. summer weekends/holidays and winter all days
- **Off-Peak:** all other hours summer; 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. winter all days
- **Super Off-Peak:** 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. winter all days

TOU-SMART

Previously referred to as TOU-D-PRIME-SOP. Similar to TOU-D-PRIME SCE rate options, with the addition of a Super-Off Peak period in the summer months. Time periods for this rate are defined as follows:

- **On-Peak:** 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. summer weekdays except holidays
- **Mid-Peak:** 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. summer weekends/holidays and winter all days
- **Off-Peak:** 9:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. all year
- **Super Off-Peak:** 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. all year
