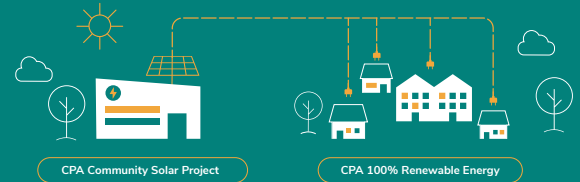




# Residents in Bassett and Avocado Heights May Qualify for a 20% Electricity Bill Discount and **100% Local Solar.**



## What is Community Solar?

Community Solar, offered by Clean Power Alliance (CPA) through its Power Share program, provides income-qualified customers in Bassett and Avocado Heights with 100% renewable solar energy sourced from their local community. Customers enrolled in Community Solar also receive a 20% discount on their monthly electricity bill.

## How does it work?

CPA purchases renewable energy on behalf of residential customers in Bassett and Avocado Heights from a solar site on top of a commercial storage facility in nearby Pico Rivera. This project allows qualified residents to benefit from the power generated by solar panels in their local community. No investment is required by the customer to take advantage of this service.

When customers are enrolled in Community Solar, they receive a 20% discount on top of other bill discounts they may already receive, including the California Alternate Rates for Energy Program (CARE) or Family Electric Rate Assistance Program (FERA). The combined discounts can save customers approximately 35%-45% on their monthly electricity bills.

## How do I sign up?

Customers can check eligibility and enrollment for Community Solar using one of the following methods:

Applicants not currently enrolled in CARE or FERA will be assisted by customer service to enroll prior to Community Solar enrollment. Once CPA's program capacity is reached, eligible applicants will be placed on a waitlist and will be enrolled as capacity becomes available.



## Who is eligible for the 20% discount?

Customers must be served by CPA and reside within a Disadvantaged Community (defined by the California Public Utilities Commission) that is within five miles of a Community Solar project site. They must also be eligible for either the CARE or FERA low-income programs. ## How will I get my 20% discount?

CPA purchases renewable energy that Southern California Edison delivers through its transmission network, and CPA customers will receive the Community Solar discount on their monthly electricity bill for as long as they are enrolled in the program.
